

University Organization Grant Program

University Credit Union is dedicated to helping campus organizations associated with our university partners. Our goal is to provide grant resources for campus organizations to help students, faculty, and the local community achieve academic, personal, and communitywide success. UCU has created the University Organization Grant Program to enhance students' community service experience and to help those in need of assistance. Community resources are scarce and the University Organization Grant Program is just one small way UCU gives back to the universities we serve.

Grant Example Criteria

Campus organizations may apply for to seek grant funds from the University Organizational Grant Program for projects such as Habitat for Humanity Building, tutoring programs for elementary students, beach clean ups, canned food drives for needy individuals, road races to raise money, blankets for the homeless, etc. Please indicate the type of activity, the number of people participating, the organization benefiting and the number of people benefiting from the project.

Eligibility

All university registered campus organizations may apply. All grant applications must be reviewed by the official university organization office. Please, only one request per university organization per academic year.

Amount

Grants may be awarded generally from \$250 to \$500 per year and will be issued to the university organization to be used towards the grant applicant description.

Application Processing

Applications are due by the first day of the quarter. The grant winners will be announced by the 15th of the following month, and the grant will be awarded by the 1st of that quarter. (Qtrs: Jan, Apr, July, Oct)

Criteria for on-going grant requests

Organizations selected as a grant recipient are required to let UCU know how the funds were used and any outcome from the use of the grant. Letters, stories, photos, and information shared on any type of social media are acceptable and may be published or redistributed by University Credit Union. Persons photographed in the released information must sign a UCU photography waiver.
